

## Call for Articles

Volume 2 of *ETICA*, to be published in September 2026, will focus on the topic of National Identity in a Time of Crisis. We welcome submissions both in Armenian and English on the theme of national identity, including but not limited to:

- Narratives of national identity: A construction or an immovable cultural heritage
- The markers of national identity: Language; Shared history; Religion; Art; Architecture; Other cultural symbols
- Shared and contested national identities
- The politics of national identity: The uses and abuses of national identities in political contexts
- The ethics of national identity: Rights, responsibilities and moral obligations
- National identities across geographical boundaries
- Identities beyond national boundaries and the impact of migration
- Multiculturalism and national identity

### Submission Guidelines:

Articles in English or in Armenian are welcome, Articles should include an abstract of approximately 300 words, followed by 5 -6 keywords.

Length: 8,000 – 10000 words, including notes and references.

Articles should be prepared for double blind refereeing. All identifying information should be removed from the text and the metadata. Please also attach a separate cover sheet with author(s)' name(s), institutional affiliation(s), contact details, and article title.

Font: Times New Roman, size 12m, with double-line spacing.

APA (author/date) reference style ([guideline example](#))

Articles should be submitted to the editors by email in Word document or a similar editable format (but not PDF) attachment.

In multi-authored articles, all authors should be included in the email with the corresponding author as the sender.

**The deadline for submissions to Volume 2 is December 15, 2025.**
